
TRIP SUMMARY & ITINERARY

DAYS 1 - 3

Arrive in one of the oldest cities in the world and the capital of China, Beijing. Meet your Educating Adventures representative who will be with you for the duration of the tour, and enjoy a half day tour of the city with plenty of photo opportunities. On day two you will tour 2-3 China based companies where you will be shown around and given a presentation.

THE GREAT WALL OF CHINA – HIKE ON ONE OF THE 7 WONDERS OF THE WORLD!

Visit a remote, less crowded and unrestored section of the Great Wall. Hike on one of the Seven Wonders of the World, the picturesque views from the Wall are worth the 3- hour walk. Enjoy a picnic lunch on the bricks which have a history of a thousand years.





DAYS 4 - 6

On day four, you will explore the jaw dropping Forbidden City. With a history of more than 600 years, the Forbidden City has served as the home of emperors and their households as well as the ceremonial and political center of Chinese government. In the company of an expert guide, take an off-the-beaten-path tour. The Heritage Walk Program will avoid the crowds and give you more detailed information about the Museum. Afterwards, board a high speed bullet train to Shanghai.

SEE THE OLD AND THE NEW SHANGHAI WITH A WALK ALONG THE RIVER BUND

Continue your business studies while being immersed in Shanghai, one of the world's most populated cities. Meet the representative from AmCham, the American Chamber of Commerce in Shanghai, followed by a Q&A session. Visit the Volkswagen factory, meet the representatives, walk through the workshops and join in a Q&A session.



DAYS 7 - 10

Travel to the beautiful waterside City of Suzhou. In the late afternoon you will take a boat ride on the Tongli water ways and be treated to a traditional Chinese meal in the evening.
